Notes :- 1. Classification : First Division 60%, Second Division 48% and Pass Class 36% in the total aggregate.

2. For a pass, a candidate is required to obtain atleast 25% marks in each theory paper and 36% marks in the total aggregate at the Previous and Final Examination separately.

3. Circle around the marks denotes deficiency in the Paper/Total

4. Sub category :- 'X' denotes those graduates who have passed Examination under 10+1+3 or 10+2+2 scheme. 'Y' denotes those graduates who have passed Examination under 10+2+3 scheme.

5. (a) Ord. 212 : A candidate who failed at the M.A. (Previous) examination, but passed in at least 50% papers prescribed for the exam. in accordance with the rules given below in clause No. (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) shall be eligible to re-appear in the failing paper(s) of Previous Examination alongwith the Final Year Examination.

(i) Where the candidate fails to secure the requisite minimum percentage of marks prescribed for a pass in the aggregate of all the papers, he shall be deemed to have passed in each such papers in which he has obtained at least 36% marks.

(ii) Where the candidate secures the requisite minimum percentage of marks prescribed for a pass in the aggregate of all the papers, he shall be deemed to have passed in each such papers in which he has obtained at least 25% marks.

(iii) For reckoning 50% of the papers at the M.A. Previous Exam., Practicals will be included and one Practical will be counted as one paper.

(iv) If the number of the papers prescribed for the previous examination is an odd number, it shall be increased by one for the purpose of reckoning P.T.O
